

ACLS - Online

The HeartCode online ACLS course is managed by Medical Staff Services and they can be reached at 666-2275. A login and password will be issued and the course is available on any computer with Internet access. The skills portion of the course is performed on a manikin in the Education Department.

HeartCode ACLS is an interactive self-directed learning program which completes all cognitive requirements for the American Heart Association ACLS Course. HeartCode ACLS includes all of the exams required for successful completion of the ACLS curriculum.

ACLS certification or recertification in three easy steps:

- Step 1** Successfully complete the Part 1 cognitive portion of the program including patient scenarios and multiple choice exam.
- Step 2** Successfully complete the Part 2 skills test administered by an AHA ACLS Instructor (Education Dept)
- Step 3** Receive an AHA ACLS Provider card.

What's new to the ACLS Program:

- An improved graphic user interface
- Addition of tabs for easier navigation of treatment option
- Ability to treat multiple rhythms (megacode) in the same scenario
- An enhanced stroke patient case
- A new respiratory arrest patient case
- Streamlining of the pharmacology treatment option
- A new code clock
- Additional supplemental materials from the ACLS Provider Manual

HeartCode 2011 ACLS includes:

Ten interactive patient scenarios, pre-course self-assessment, team dynamics lesson, and full texts of the ACLS Provider Manual, 2011 AHA Guidelines for CPR and ECC, and ACLS Core Drugs.

For members of the Kootenai Medical Staff there is no additional cost for the online course as it is covered under your medical staff reappointment fees. For those not on staff the cost is \$150 for the access code information.
